Rowan Class Approach to learning and development

In Rowan class we follow a child-led system in how we plan the learning opportunities, set out the environment (indoors and outdoors) and assess learning and development.

As always, we ensure all our planning reflects the interests and needs of the children, however we do have themes we like to introduce the children to in order to inspire them with their learning and we do this to meet both the Year 1 curriculum requirements as well as the EYFS curriculum.

Understanding the World/ Science

We will be learning where about the difference between fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

We will also be looking at materials, their properties, and what they can be used for.

We will also start looking at collecting data for experiments.

We will also be continuing with our exploration of the seasons.

Understanding the World/ Geography and History

Geography- We will be learning about the world's oceans and the continents as well as the water cycle!

We will then look at the world's hot/cold places, the equator and the features of these places.

History- We will be looking at events from our country that happened in the past (e.g. the first aeroplane flight).

Art and Design, ICT and PE

Art and Design- We will be exploring different artists and the similarities/differences between their work. We will continue learning different art techniques across different mediums.

ICT- We will be using the computers to create and store digital work.

PE- We will learning how to play as a team, attacking and defending!

Writing- adult directed

In Reception- we will be looking at using our phonics knowledge to help us independently write words and longer sentences.

In Year 1- we will be working on consistently remembering our capital letters at the beginning of a sentence, for names, places and the personal pronoun 'I'.

We will also be working on re-reading our work and checking our work independently.

We are going to be exploring poetry, learning some simple poems and creating our own.

Maths-adult directed

In Reception- we will start with focusing on number and place value- counting, ordering and recognising numbers to 20 and beyond. We will then focus on our counting and start to explore groups of objects, adding to them and taking parts away.

In Year 1- we will start with focusing on number and place value by confidently counting and recognising numbers to 100 in steps of one, five and ten. We will become confident distinguishing between a teen number and a tens numbers (e.g.18 and 80). We will revisit addition and subtraction before moving on to start multiplication and division.

RE

We will be looking at whether some stories are more important than others. We will be looking at the Old Testament and stories that are particularly important to Jewish as well as Christian believers.
