$$\frac{1}{3} \text{ of } 24 = \square$$

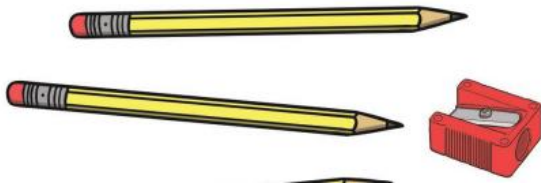
$$\frac{1}{3} \text{ of } 3 = \square$$
