French

As linguists, we will continue to learn common phrases, feeling, emotions and the names for French school subjects. In year 6 we will learn time and daily routines.

English

As writers, we will be exploring figurative language and the epic story of Beowulf. This will share links with our Viking topic – leading monster narratives, historical reports and playscripts. As readers we will explore a range of texts through reciprocal reading in groups and as a whole class.

Mathematics

As mathematicians we will continue to follow the White Rose scheme of learning. This term sees the following areas being covered: place value, the four operations, fractions, statistics and geometry.

As theologians we will be exploring these BIG questions:

Big Question 1:

Big Question 2:

What is the trinity?

Art & DT

As artists we will be using different painting techniques and colour mixing to show mood and tone – this will be linked to our creative writing around the Nordic lands.

Also, we will be selecting materials, planning and creating models of Viking treasure.

PE

As athletes and gymnasts, we will use Jasmine Real PE to develop our cognitive approaches to exercise and teamwork. Specifically looking at developing performance and analysing strengths and weaknesses.

Music

As musicians we use the Charanga scheme of learning to develop our music skills. We will be learning about rhythm and tempo.

Science

As scientific thinkers and investigators we will experiment and explore forces, magnetism, light and sound.

Humanities

As historians we will be exploring the world of the Vikings – building on our knowledge of Anglo-Saxons to understand how the ancient world was shaped by their growing empire.

PSHE

We will continue to develop and focus on developing our understanding of the 'zones of regulation', whilst exploring the concepts of family, community, society and diversity.

Computing

As computer scientists we will continue to look at the importance of staying safe online. Also, we will use the ICT123 scheme of learning to develop our understanding of E-books – leading us to produce our own.
